Graduates of our WV Cosmetology\* programs are prepared to take the licensure exam through the WV State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists in order to practice in the state of West Virginia (you may apply for licensing in other states if you meet their hour requirements).

\* Massage Therapy is not included in our Cosmetology programs licensure disclosure. They are prepared to take the MBLEX in their state of study (you may apply for licensing in other states if you meet their hour requirements).
